#### The forum will include:

**1-The main <u>international conference</u> for young researchers:** for Youth less than 40 years old from all over the world including graduate, post graduate students as well as masters and PhD holders.

Abstracts should be no more than 250 words with 250 words short biography. Registration is free but participants are expected to handle their travel expenses and accommodation. Selection of participants will depend on excellence of presented abstracts/research.

2- Capacity building training for young scientists/students (Internationals/Egyptians)

Training sessions will be provided on different topics including science diplomacy and science communication for all young scientists and students participating at the conference (i.e. speakers or poster presenters).

## <u>3-Students` competition (science future</u> talents; SFT)-for Egyptians only

The competition will be open for teams (2-5 members) from all talented and innovating Egyptian students (non PhD holders) including high schools` students within age range of **17-30** <u>years old</u> in fields related to sustainable development as: <u>Food, water, energy, environment, health and education</u>. Each team should submit a 250 words abstract on only one of the above mentioned topics. Preference for selection will be given to innovative solutions for real problems based ideas.
