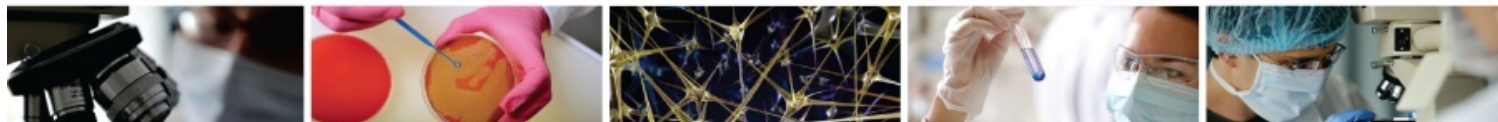


Senior Research Officer – Immunology in Cancer & Infection

The successful candidate will operate within a larger team that works closely with a major pharmaceutical partner company. Key duties will include testing the activity of immunotherapeutics in mouse models of primary tumour growth and metastasis. Other duties will involve characterising the expression of surface immune receptors on multiple leukocyte lineages in tumours and the periphery pre- and post-stimulation with new immunomodulatory compounds using flow cytometry.

Responsibilities will include:

- Perform research as directed by the Project Officer and Laboratory Head
- Working independently and drive project outcomes with initiative expected from an experienced researcher
- Assist in supervision of a research assistant and other junior technical staff
- Provide experience and technical expertise to the research group as a whole
- Lead and promote compliance with ethical and professional work practices

The successful candidate should have a relevant PhD with a strong background in immunology. Experience with animal experimentation, in particular tumour models, and high definition multiparametric flow cytometry is essential.

Experience in lymphocyte immunology, and cancer immunotherapy is highly desirable. This position would suit a researcher who is highly motivated and has an interest in applied science.

Applicants are required to have:

- Completed a PhD that includes training in immunology
- Knowledge in cancer immunotherapy
- Experience with multiparameter flow cytometry
- Proficiency with experimental tumour models in mice
